Most weeks we will be focusing on one specific letter and there are many activities you can do at home to help reinforce what we do at school.

You don't need many supplies and activities can be done while reading together, grocery shopping or even preparing meals.

While reading:

*Point to both upper and lowercase letters and make their sound.

*Find/discuss pictures that may begin with the letter.
